Here's How to Avoid “Throw-Aways”:

- *Bring reusable containers* (dishes, sandwich boxes, food & drink containers) which are taken back home. These save you money by reducing the purchase of paper products.
- *Avoid polystyrene* (Styrofoam®) products. They may be cheap but are harmful to our environment. Remember: Plastic comes from oil. Reduce oil consumption. Avoid “throw-away” plastic items.
- *Use cloth napkins.* If you do buy paper, buy unbleached or white. Color dyes are more toxic to natural systems.
- *Use cloth table cover.* Old beach towel or blanket works well and doesn't blow away.
- *Shop wisely.* Avoid over-packaged products like costly convenience packs (cheese & crackers, soup & sandwich).
- *Buy beverages in returnable bottles.*
- *Recycle glass, aluminum cans, plastic liter bottles.* Take home or use our receptacles.
